## MONDAYS: February 5 – April 23 (no classes 2/19, 3/26)

<p><b>Secret Agent Lab (K-2):</b> Do you think you have what it takes to discover “who done it?” This program is for you! From secret communications and crime science to the inner workings of our cells, this program is sure to make you go hmmm! Sleuth out the answers to many of life’s mysteries!</p>	<p><b>Art Brains (K-3):</b> ART BRAINS inspires kids to think independently, creatively problem-solve, and expand on their ideas in an atmosphere of high imagination. Experimenting with a variety of materials, kids will draw, paint, sculpt, build, write, and more in a single session!</p>	<p><b>Let’s Make a Play! (K-3):</b> Led by professional teaching artists, students will explore acting, voice, movement, character development and storytelling through the lens of theatre games and exercises. Join us for some fun, and let’s make a play!</p>	<p><b>Tae Kwondo (K-5):</b> Master Yang returns to Maury for another amazing season of Tae Kwondo! Young martial artists develop discipline, focus and physical fitness in this popular martial arts class. Good for all ages! *There is a \$20.00 uniform fee for new students.</p>
<p><b>Kids Need Chess! (1-5):</b> Beginners learn the fundamentals &amp; strengthen their skills. Intermediate students focus on tactics &amp; strategies. State champion Coach Charlie Edelman teaches puzzles, tournaments, stories, and more to keep kids hungry for learning and play!</p>	<p><b>Cursive &amp; Calligraphy Arts (3-5):</b> Calligraphy is the art of beautiful writing. Explore the history of calligraphy across the world with projects in various forms and styles. Learn the tools to continue forming your own cursive handwriting and many calligraphy projects to come!</p>	<p><b>Coding with Silver Knights (2-5):</b> Create stories, games, and animations using a visual programming language called Scratch. New coders learn the basics while experienced coders are challenged to create a wide variety of more complex programs. ## TUESDAYS: February 6 – April 17 (no classes 3/27)

<p><b>Hip Hop (K-3):</b> Tippi Toes Dance teachers will have you dancin’ to the beat in our Hip Hop class! Students start with warm-ups and stretching exercises, then learn basic jazz and hip hop technique, choreography and combos to current, age-appropriate dance music!</p>	<p><b>WeDo Creative Robotics (K-3):</b> Using an expanded construction set, students build more complex mechanisms and robots, and use their innovation and critical thinking skills to engineer their own creative solutions to exciting challenges.</p>	<p><b>My First Lemonade Stand (K-5):</b> Learn how to make lemonade and how to earn money selling it! Students learn marketing, finance and strategy in a supportive team environment. Students raise funds for the school with their lemonade stand sales in the spring!</p>	<p><b>Kids Yoga with Nurse Harper! (1-5):</b> Maury’s own Nurse Harper brings her yoga skills &amp; her calm and caring energy to help students gain strength, flexibility, focus, and mindfulness through the practice of yoga. Improve your bodies and minds with Nurse Harper! Yoga mats provided.</p>
<p><b>Set Design: ALADDIN (3-5):</b> Create a whole new world with Ms. Tio! Transform the Maury cafetorium into Aladdin’s Middle East for the spring musical. Paint backdrops and build sets &amp; props. Ride the magic carpet as we use our creativity to make this year’s musical soar!</p>	<p><b>We provide students with transportation, snacks, an onsite coordinator and dismissal assistance during after school enrichment.</b></p>	<p><b>Advanced Minecraft (3-5):</b> Students learn how to install, run and create customized Minecraft mods. They also customize graphics &amp; gameplay, and develop problem-solving and teamwork skills, tackling a variety of challenges with their classmates.</p>	<p><b>FunFit! (3-5):</b> Ms. Houston teaches a comprehensive circuit training program encouraging physical activity and athletic performance. Students improve coordination, flexibility, balance, strength, speed, and endurance, all while having fun and learning to love fitness!</p>

## WEDNESDAYS: February 7 – April 18 (no classes 3/28)

<p><b>KidSpanish (K-2):</b> KidSpanish teaches students oral and written skills so they grow comfortable using the Spanish language. Students sing songs, write sentences, and engage in games, crafts, and activities designed to practice vocabulary and improve speaking skills.</p>	<p><b>Tiny Chefs (K-3):</b> Who loves cheeseballs, truffles, and other bite sized snacks?! Get ready for some amazing “ball” shaped goodies. Students will “round ‘em up” by creating Popcorn Balls, Snowball Truffles, and meatballs. There’s nothing square about this class!</p>	<p><b>Zumba Kids! (K-5):</b> Zumba Kids is a Latin inspired dance fitness party designed with kid friendly music, movements, and routines. This class helps children make friends, get active after school, and increase self confidence as they learn to dance with the class.</p>	<p><b>Art of the Middle East (1-2):</b> Take a magic carpet ride and explore the art of the Middle East! Ms. Tio will teach our younger artists about the beautiful traditions of Aladdin’s world through the art of Persia: calligraphy, tile work, weaving, painting, and metalwork.</p>
<p><b>ALADDIN–KIDS, the Musical (3-5):</b> Calling all singers! We need your help in rounding out our chorus for the spring musical production of “Aladdin—Kid’s Edition.” If you love to sing, then this class is for you, so jump on the magic carpet into a whole new world of musical theatre!</p>	<p><b>*NOTE:</b> Students enrolled in <b>ALADDIN</b> are required to attend all dress rehearsals and performances at the end of the spring session. More details on our registration website.</p>	<p><b>Advanced Parkour (4-5):</b> Know Obstacles Parkour is an advanced class with an emphasis on basic Parkour skills, movement &amp; fitness. This class is designed for older students who love to jump, roll, climb and leap, or who have prior parkour or gymnastics experience.</p>	<p><b>Global Impact Leaders (4-5):</b> Want to help change the world? Students learn event and communication skills to raise awareness about the global water crisis. Students work together to execute a series of fundraising events that raise funds for a clean water system for a school in South Africa.</p>

## THURSDAYS: February 15 – April 26 (no classes 2/8, 3/29)

<p><b>French Club (K-2):</b> Children learn basic words and sentences by doing fun and creative activities with music, art, games, movement and food. Children learn salutations, colors, numbers, weather, animals and food. They also learn about some of the 29 countries who have French as their language!</p>	<p><b>Viva Violin (K-2):</b> Learn how to play the violin in this fun ensemble group class! Rental instruments and music are provided to each student during the course, and parents are invited to “Parent Day” on the last day of class to hear what their kids have learned!</p>	<p><b>Kids’ Parkour! (K-3):</b> Urban Evolution brings safety, discipline, and conditioning together with Parkour &amp; creative obstacle courses to challenge our students’ mental and physical abilities. Our teacher-to-student ratio allows us to work through challenges for all our students.</p>	<p><b>Registration opens at 7pm on Sunday, January 7th. Mark your calendars &amp; set your alarms!</b></p>
<p><b>Reptiles Alive! (K-5):</b> Snakes, scales, and lizard tails are just a few of the things we learn about in Reptiles Alive! A friendly and professional wildlife educator introduces students to different live animals, including amphibians, iguanas, snakes, cockroaches, lizards and other amazing creatures!</p>	<p><b>Pottery Around the World (K-5):</b> Jimmy Potters Workshop provides children with the experience of a clay studio in a mobile setting. From Van Gogh to Cambodia’s Water Festival, students create through clay and glaze their own creations, traveling the world one masterpiece at a time!</p>	<p><b>Groovy Guitar (3-5):</b> Learn how to play the guitar in this fun ensemble group class, designed with our older students in mind. Rental instruments and music are provided to each student during the course, and parents are invited to the last day of class to hear what their kids have learned!</p>	<p><b>Creative Writing: Girls’ Voices (4-5):</b> Like to write? Want to connect with other girls who like to write? Come join our creative writing circle! We use a combination of mindfulness and creative writing strategies to find and develop our unique writing voices!</p>
